

Event report folder restructuring


- The Cognos Event Report folder structure has changed to better organize benchmark reports, event reports, medical center specific reports, medication error reports and work place violence reports.
- The Benchmark Reports folder contains existing benchmark event reports for all medical centers.
- The Event Reports folder contains new benchmark event reports for all medical centers.
- The Medical Center Specific folder contains operational reports for your medical center only.
- The Medication Error Reports folder contains benchmark medication error reports for all medical centers.
- The Work Place Violence reports folder contains benchmark work place violence reports.

Benchmark Reports

- The new Benchmark Reports folder is found within the Event Reports folder.
- The Benchmark Reports folder contains all the existing benchmark reports on event data.





Benchmark Reports



General Event Reports

- The General Event Reports folder is found within the overall higher level Event Reports folder.
- The Event Reports folder will contain new benchmark reports on event data. As the phase 1 reports are re-designed the new replacement reports will be found in this folder.




New Reports

- The General Event Reports folder contains the new Severity Level Dashboard and Event Detail-Operational report
- In the Event Detail Operational Report users with event detail access will see that Brief Factual Discription of the event. All others will see general details.

- The Severity Level Dashboard includes the ability to drill down to the Event Detail Report. However a known issue with the Cognos system has disabled this feature. It is currently being worked on.
